### **Teaching Children: the Learning Game**

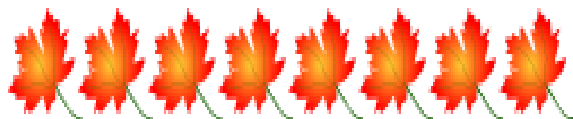

### **Kids and Biblical Truths**

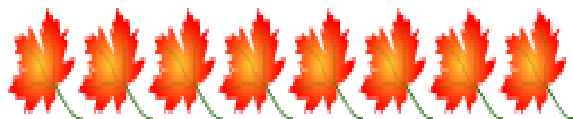
